## Dear Friends and Family in Christ,

My name is Dr. Michael Le, and I am honored to serve as Vice President of K-12 Schools for REAP International (Roever Educational Assistance Program). For 20 years, God has allowed me to serve through the ministry in education. Those experiences have helped to move me in a new role witnessing what the Lord is doing through REAP in Vietnam. REAP exists to bring hope, education, and the love of Christ to children who otherwise have none. Through two of our school campuses already established in Vietnam, students are receiving quality education while being surrounded by care, truth, and opportunity.

On my recent trip, I saw God open new doors. After the Lunar New Year, REAP will launch two additional schools, including one located inside a Buddhist temple that shelters 130 orphaned children. Many of these children were abandoned on the streets or left at the temple gates. Without birth records, they are denied access to public education, but they are not denied access to God's love. I spent time with these children, laughing with them, listening to their stories, and teaching them the simple song "Jesus Loves Me." As their voices filled the room, I was reminded of this truth:

This is why REAP is stepping in to establish a school within the temple, providing reading, math, English, life skills, and most importantly, the message that every child is seen, valued, and loved by God.

This ministry is not about buildings, it is about changing lives. One child discovering hope. One education opens a future. One song planting the truth that Jesus loves them.

We cannot do this alone. If God is stirring your heart, I invite you to partner with us in one or more of these ways:
